



Religious Education

In Religious Education we will begin this term by looking at our Confirmation unit which focuses on the Holy Spirit.

In the second half of the term we will move on to looking at Baptism and how we are all a part of God's family.

English

This term in English the students will be consolidating how to write a narrative and learning how to write a persuasive text. Spelling and Phonics and Dictation tasks have all been linked with their point of need.. Reading will incorporate both group, individual and paired tasks with a focus on comprehension and fluency.

Homework

Homework should take no more than about 15 minutes at this age. There will be home reading, Spelling, High Frequency word learning and a maths sheet. It goes home on Monday and is due on Friday.

Health

In Term Two we will be continuing to use the Keeping Safe: Child Protection Curriculum. The following concepts will be taught:

- Rights and Responsibilities
- Identity and Relationships
- Power in Relationships - Bullying & Fairness
- Trust & Safety Networks

Science

In our Physical Sciences units this term, students will be experimenting to learn about light, sound and push and pull forces.

Art

This term students are looking at form. They will do this by exploring clay and drawing.

Mathematics

In Mathematics this term we will begin by recapping and focusing on addition and subtraction strategies as well as place value, recognising and ordering numbers to and beyond 100 and skip counting. We will then move on to two dimensional shapes and fractions. Finally, we will finish the term off by looking at months, seasons and measurement – with a focus on length and area.

Music

Term Two involves Music Feste. Their item is a contemporary version of This Old Man. The students will be practicing their item which involves singing and percussion instruments. Students will develop performance skills such as singing and playing in correct time and technique. They will be involved with input on how their performance should look and sound like. It is also a time to practice good audience behaviour.

Indonesian

Topics that will be covered during Indonesian lessons this term include: Time, day and months, body parts, clothes, weather conditions, classroom objects.

HASS

Our focus in HASS this term is HistoryThe students will be learning about the concepts of:

- Significant People and Places in our community
- Constructed, Managed and Natural Places

Technologies

In Technologies this term we will be using the digital skills we learnt from last term to investigate different materials – how they are made and why they are useful. We will finish the term using our knowledge to create a bird house.

Physical Education

During Physical Education lessons this term, children will be preparing for the Cross Country Carnival through endurance running activities. The children learn about soccer before commencing their team game preparation for the Term Three Athletics Carnival.
