



YEAR 3/4 TERM 2 OVERVIEW 2022

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RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This term in Religious Education students will be exploring the units of Confirmation and Baptism. In Term One, the year 3/4's will also be leading the school in the Sacred Heart Feast Day Mass on Friday the 24th of June.

ENGLISH

This term in English students will revisit the writing genre of recounts and narratives and will begin exploring the genre of expositions. Students will also be working from the Diana Rigg Spelling Program as well as participating in numerous opportunities for reading throughout the week.

HOMEWORK

Homework will commence in Week Two and will be given out on Monday and due back on Friday. It will include look, say, cover, write, check for their spelling lists for the week. As well as nightly reading and maths activities linked to what we will be focusing on during our numeracy lessons during the week.

MATHEMATICS

This term in Mathematics students will revisit their understanding of place value and continue their learning in both the Number and Algebra strand, as well as the Measurement and Geometry strand. This term will also see students exploring the Statistics and Probability strand.

The following concepts will be covered:

- Place Value
- Subtraction Mental Strategies
- Subtraction Written Strategies
 - 2D & 3D shapes
 - Volume and Capacity
 - Symmetry
- Data Collection and Interpretation

TECHNOLOGIES

This term in Technologies students will be using the 6Ds of Solution Fluency to produce an invention that solves a problem they have identified within our community or wider society. Students will be working through the 6Ds of; define, discover, dream, design, deliver and debrief.

SCIENCE

In the Physical Sciences units this term, students will be experimenting to learn about the production and movement of heat and how contact and non-contact forces can be exerted.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

During Physical Education lessons this term, children will be preparing for the Cross Country Carnival through endurance running activities during lessons. The children will also be involved in a unit of work focussed on soccer before commencing their team game preparation for the Term Three Athletics Carnival.

HEALTH

This term students will be following the SDERA Challenges and Choices Resilience and Wellbeing education. Students will first be tuning into the content to explain why bad things happen and having an optimistic versus pessimistic view. Students will then be finding out ways to be brave and diffusing situations.

VISUAL ARTS

This term students are looking at form. They will do this by exploring clay and drawing.

HASS

This term in HASS students will be completing their work on Civics and Citizenships. Students will then be looking at History, focusing on celebrations and commemorations in Australia and around the world. Students will also begin to look at different stories of the first fleet.

MUSIC

Term Two is the time in which we have Music Feste. This year, we will be performing See You Later Alligator. This will be exciting for the students who will be playing instruments in layers. Some will be playing bass while others will be playing a simplified melody. There will be a lot of teamwork involved to have their music item at performance level with practicing playing with correct timing and technique. It will be wonderful for the students to hear their own progress as they come close to the time of performing.
